Region: Niederösterreich (Weinviertel)

Grape variety: Riesling

Vintage: 2017

Vineyard: loess / sand, south-facing slope

Vinification: The Grande Reserve is a selection of the best Riesling Grapes. They were selected in the very late autumn. The whole processing is very gently. Fermentation is steel tanks. Contact with fine yeast gives the wine another dimension. The result is a classy, elegant Wine with high Potential!

A Riesling with an exotic style and fine acidity. We at the WEINRIEDER winery are also absolute cross-border commuters, especially when it comes to the Riesling variety. With the late harvest, we take a very high risk in order to wrest the best from nature. "Riesling at the limit"

Tasting notes: Solid, vegetal and earthy aroma of candied yellow fruit with herbal notes. Juicy, sweet fruit on the palate, again vegetal notes, fine acidity, persistent, powerful and creamy, excellent substance and incredible depth, endless finish

Serve well chilled - with foie gras, fruity dishes, a wine for meditation ...
